Scratch Covers

- Wipe on, wipe off.
- Scratch covers, of course, are merely band-aids. They temporarily blend out scratches where the finish is gone.
- Surface treatments will not penetrate wood finishes. They only color the scratches, typically with a light or dark version.
- Cannot provide the restorative advantages of Restor-A-Finish.



Howard's Restor-A-Finish

- Wipe on, wipe off.
- Permanently restores the existing varnish, lacquer or shellac - without removing it.
- Cleans the surface and penetrates stain through the existing finish to restore color and luster.
- Restores any shade utilizing nine different colors.
- White heat rings and water marks, sun fade, oxidation, smoke damage and most other blemishes can be quickly eliminated.



Refinishers and Strippers

- Lots of work!
- A refinisher dissolves and removes the existing varnish, lacquer, or shellac.
- After the finish is removed the wood has to be conditioned and a new finish applied.
- Refinishers do not restore color.
- Devalues original antiques.
- Refinishers or strippers should only be used when the damage is so severe that it cannot be restored.
